Bring Your Own Device Policy

Use of Personal Devices, Cell Phones and School Computers

- The use of school computers as well as personal devices (including cell phones) falls under St. Cloud Christian School's Acceptable Use Policy, found in the student handbook.
- Computers and personal **devices will not be used for personal or entertainment purposes** during the school day unless authorized by the student's teacher.
- The use of a computer or personal **device is not to be a distraction** in any way to teachers or students and must not disrupt class in any way.
- Students will **not be permitted to use cell phones for texting or making calls** during the school day. Calls from school should be reserved for emergencies and made using the school office phones. Parents should not text students during the school day, expecting a response. They need to call the office to leave a message.
- Students shall **make no attempts to circumvent the school's network security** and/or filtering policies or. This includes setting up proxies and downloading programs to bypass security.
- **Students shall not distribute pictures or video of students or staff without their permission.** (Distribution can be as small as emailing/texting to one other person or as large as posting image or video online.)

Consequences for Misuse/Disruption: (one or more may apply)

- Device taken away for the period.
- Device taken away and kept in the front office until parent picks it up.
- Student is not allowed to use personal devices at school.
- Disciplinary Referral resulting in ISS or OSS.
